

Letter of Intent for Cooperation
between
the Centre for Peace and Justice of BRAC University, Dhaka, Bangladesh
and
the Department of International Refugee Law and Migration Law of the International
Institute of Humanitarian Law, Sanremo, Italy

With this Letter, the Centre for Peace and Justice of BRAC University in Dhaka, Bangladesh (hereinafter – the Centre), expresses its interest in the cooperation with the Department of International Refugee Law and Migration Law of the International Institute of Humanitarian Law, Sanremo, Italy (hereinafter – the Department), for the purpose of fostering the exchange of knowledge and best practices in teaching between the parties and otherwise supporting the parties in fulfilment of their respective mandates, and undertakes to respect the following commitments, mutually agreed upon by the mentioned parties:

I. The Centre for Peace and Justice will:

- Promote the courses and initiatives of the Department to its partners and students;
- Deliver interventions at the invitation of the Department to promote the work of the Centre as a best practice for engaging refugee communities in academic research;
- Record a promotional video about the Centre's engagement with refugee communities in Cox's Bazar, to be promoted as a best practice among the participants of the Department's courses on Teaching Refugee Law through its Online Learning Platform.

II. The Centre agrees, jointly with the Department, to:

- Organize exchange study visits for selected staff of the Department and the Centre to Bangladesh and Sanremo, Italy, respectively, for the purpose of exchanging best practices on pedagogical training and facilitating direct communication with refugee communities in Cox's Bazar;
- Determine quota of BRAC University students and its partners for priority attendance to the Department's Online Course on International Protection for Postgraduates and Junior Professionals.
- Develop and implement courses and initiatives on international refugee protection for students and partners of BRAC University and refugees in Cox's Bazar;
- Develop and implement courses and initiatives on international refugee protection for policymakers and other relevant stakeholders in Bangladesh.

III. The Centre further agrees to:

- Coordinate with the Department its outreach and public information initiatives related to the promotion of the parties' joint activities, and to seek the Department's approval for the use of its name and/or logo;
- Coordinate with the Department the fundraising efforts in the process of development and implementation of the activities outlined in this Letter;
- Maintain confidentiality with regards to any information received from the Department orally or in writing. The Centre shall keep such information confidential and cannot disclose any related information without the Department's prior written consent, except for the following information that shall not be a subject to such confidentiality:

(a) information that is or will be generally known to the public (provided that such information does not result from the receiving party's unauthorized disclosure to the public);

(b) disclosure of such information is required by applicable laws;

(c) information to be disclosed to the Directors or the legal or financial advisors of the parties for the transactions contemplated under the specialized agreements concluded for the purposes of the cooperation.


- Accept that, each party is and shall remain the owner of all intellectual property that it owns or controls as of the date of exchange of Letters of Intent for Cooperation or that it develops or acquires thereafter.

IV. The activities outlined in this Letter shall refer to the period between January - December 2023. The parties will agree to a specific implementation timeline, roles and responsibilities of the parties, as well as financial obligations and scholarships allocation when applicable, for each of the activities in a


separate exchange of documents, subject to their mutual agreement and the availability of funds.

- V. The Centre reserves the right to withdraw the Letter with the intention of ceasing cooperation by providing a one month written notice to the Department.
